

# Victor Harbor Croquet Club Golf Croquet 2026 Tournament

## Conditions of Play

Play starts at 9:00 each day. Please check in by 8:30. We will have a player briefing at 8:45 each morning. If you have a Bye game 1, you should arrive by 9:30.

The club will be open for registration and practice on Friday, 20 March from 1 to 3pm. Please present your handicap card and State registration card when registering. You can also register on the morning of your event.

The draw for all events will be available at registration. The draw and Conditions of Play will also be available on the club website Victor Harbor Croquet Club at <https://victorcroquet.com/tournament-gala-events/> a week before the tournament.

Courts are available for practice each morning from 8:00am. An additional 5 minute warm-up will be permitted before your first game of the day. If you have had a break of more than an hour, you may have a warm-up where space permits.

Players are asked to be ready to start games in an expedient manner. For any late arrivals, please phone the club on 8552 8832 or the Tournament Manager on 0402 324 763.

Handicap cards are needed for all games.

All games will be 13 points or 60 minutes. Games end on the bell unless scores are tied, then finish the hoop you are playing. Scoring clips will be used. The winners of each event or block will be decided on the number of games won, then net hoops (hoops won *less* hoops lost).

Courts may be double-banked and clocks are available for each game. If your game cannot move to the next hoop in order, stop your clock until play can resume.

Quadway hoops will be used and set at 3 11/16.

WCF GC 6<sup>th</sup> Edition 2022 rules and subsequent official rulings apply. *Supervising* referees and SA Umpires will be available.

*Doubles* games will be played in 3 blocks, seeded by handicap ranking, with a double round robin. (Tues & Wed.)

*Home and Away Doubles*, games will be played in 2 blocks, single round robin, winner of block A playing off against winner of Block B. (Monday) Visiting players will be paired with a club member or another visitor in *handicap balanced* pairs.

*Singles* games will be played in 3 blocks; players seeded by handicap ranking, in a double round robin. (Sat & Sun).

The prizes for the winners of each event will be presented at the finish of that event.

Victor Harbor Croquet Club Weather Policy will be followed for hot or inclement weather. For court attire, whites, club colours, state colours or *appropriate sporting attire* is acceptable. Conditions of Play may be altered at the discretion of the TM and players notified at player briefings.
